The author of any otherwise acceptable paper may have it published immediately by paying the entire cost of publication; publication of such a paper does not affect the priority of any paper on the regular schedule.

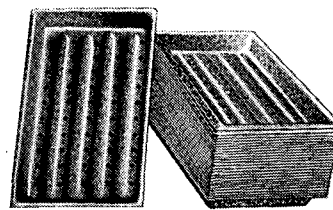
